Recommend approval which would allow Department Director to approve possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages in City facilities for activities such as special events, fundraising functions, and adult recreation programs.



GRIMES ORDINANCE _____

AN ORDINANCE DELETING AND REPLACING GRIMES CODE OF ORDINANCES SECTION 47.20 TO PERMIT AND REGULATE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE POSSESSION AND CONSUMPTION ON GRIMES PUBLIC PROPERTY

BE IN ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRIMES, IOWA:

SECTION 1. Purpose. The purpose of this Ordinance is to delete and replace Grimes Code of Ordinance Section 47.20 to permit and regulate alcoholic beverage possession and consumption in Grimes Public Property.

SECTION 2. Amendment. The Grimes Code of Ordinance Section 47.20 is hereby deleted and replace by the following ordinance:

47.20 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE POSSESSION AND CONSUMPTION ON CITY PROPERTY.

It is unlawful for any person to use, possess or consume beer, wine or alcoholic liquor beverage on any city property, including city hall, city public works, city library, city community center, city parks, park roads and public property or parking areas directly adjacent to city buildings and parks, unless that person is (1) possessing or consuming the beverage under the limited and specified permission granted by an event permit or park facility reservation issued by the Grimes Park Department Director or the Director's designee, (2) has purchased the beverage from a liquor licensee operating at the city park under a concession permit issued by the City of Grimes or the City's event designee, or (3) is attending a function where alcohol is being allowed by the responsible City Department Director. For purposes of this ordinance, the definition of city park includes all city designated park property including city sports complexes.

SECTION 3. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of these ordinances are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. Severability Clause. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 5: Effective Date. This ordinance shall be in effect after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

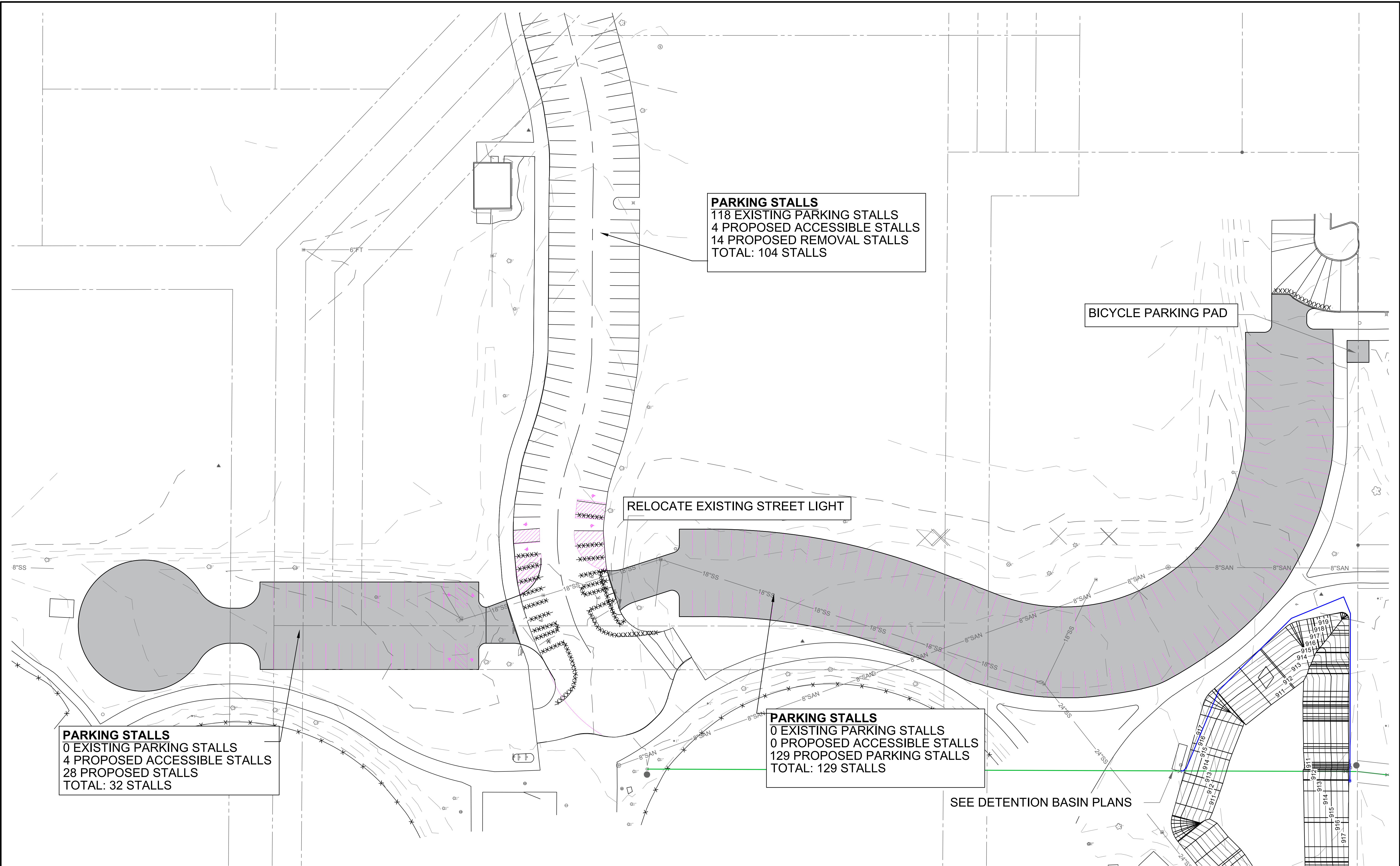
