COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT SUMMARY

Our team had a wonderful and productive experience engaging with Grimes community members to receive feedback on Water Works Park's exciting features. Attached to this email you will find scans of the sticker exercise community members utilized to voice their opinions on the splashpad, playground, natural playscape, site furnishings, structures, and planting features that are to be included in future development. Please also find the sign in sheet from the Engagement Event attached to this document. Our team greatly appreciates the opportunity to engage with the City of Grimes and their community members, thank you!

Below is a summarized list of the preferred amenities per the community's feedback.

SPLASHPAD

- The most positively reviewed precedents were naturalistic features, although the surface jets, slides, and water cannons were also voted upon. Specifically, precedents G, B, A2, C2.

PLAYGROUND

- Playground F was actively the most popular equipment, with colors 1 and 2 as the preferred finish.

NATURAL PLAYSCAPE

- The Eagles Nest and Rock Slide features received the most positive feedback with 8 votes each.

SITE FURNISHINGS

- Chair D, Table B, Pedestrian Light B, Bike Rack C, Bench's D & A, Bollard D, and Receptacles B & C were favored. Paver B was also considered the community favorite.

STRUCTURES

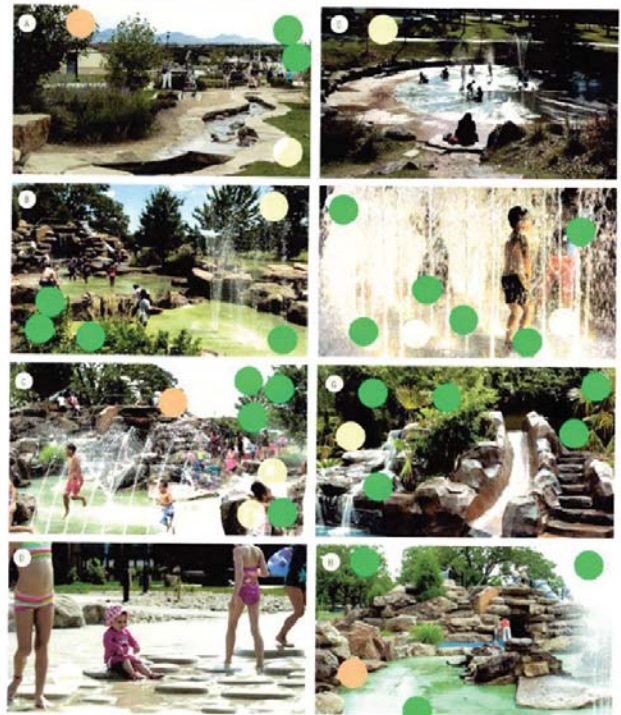
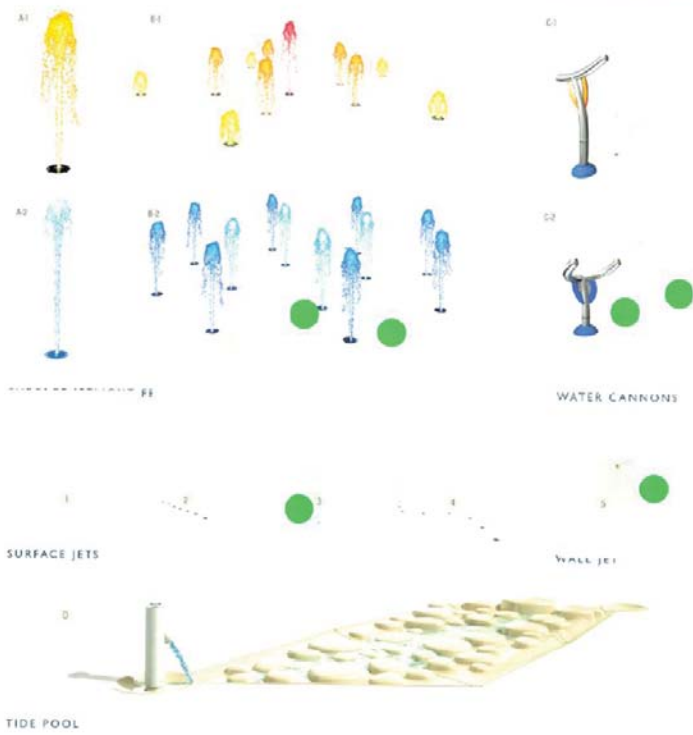
- Shelter D and Sign B were considered the community favorites

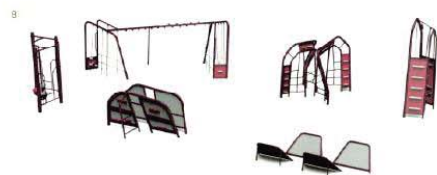
